Evaluation of your pregnancy is a multi-disciplinary approach. Perinatal sonographers, genetic counselors, perinatal nursing, and physicians will work together towards developing recommendations for the management of your pregnancy. Detailed communication with your obstetrical care providers is an integral part of this team approach.

STATE OF THE ART SERVICES

Our practice is the leader in providing consultative and technological services for obstetrical care providers and their patients in Central Pennsylvania. Revolutionary **4D ultrasound imaging** is now available for fetal evaluation. We have the distinction of being accredited by the American Institute for Ultrasound in Medicine (AIUM).

Complete anatomical ultrasound (level 2)

Detailed evaluation of the fetal anatomy including measurements of the head, body, and extremities as well as careful observation of any structures able to be visualized by ultrasound

Evaluation of fetal growth/position/ amniotic fluid (level 1)

Fetal Echocardiography

Special ultrasound imaging of the heart and its major vessels, including blood flow studies (Doppler)

Ultrasound assessment of the cervix

Especially useful in patients at risk for preterm delivery

Biophysical testing

Checking baby's well-being by observing movements or assessing the amniotic fluid level

4D Ultrasound imaging

Provides more detailed evaluation for certain fetal abnormalities such as cleft lip/palate or spinal abnormalities (i.e. spina bifida)

Genetic Services

Clinical genetic assessment and genetic counseling are available for patients with family history of genetic disorders or who have a current pregnancy at increased risk for a genetic problem

Amniocentesis

Procedure to obtain amniotic fluid that can be used for genetic testing, analyzed for infection, or used to check the baby's lung maturity

First Trimester Screening

Using a combination of ultrasound measurements, maternal age related risk, and maternal serum biochemical markers, about 90% of babies at risk for Down syndrome and Trisomy 18 can be detected. Screening takes place between 11 weeks 1 day and 13 weeks 6 days of pregnancy. A positive screen indicates testing for definitive diagnosis is warranted.

In utero treatment

Blood sampling of the baby and in some cases direct treatment of the baby can be performed *during pregnancy*

Consultation with other specialists

Availability of pediatric cardiology and pediatric surgery are examples of the consultative resources available for you during pregnancy
